

## Rules to be kept when wastes are placed at the designated sites.

Time to place the wastes at the designated sites	From sunrise to 8:30 a.m. of the day of collection (Do NOT place the wastes at the sites on the previous day of collection.)
Bags to be used for putting the wastes into inside	Bags designated by Komono Town (Transparent or semi-transparent bags can be used for plastic wastes.)
Size of wastes	The size of wastes should be smaller than 50 cm in length and 5 cm in thickness. (*Refer to the table below.)
Weight per bag	A bag should be picked up by one hand (max. 7 kg).
Packing method	The open end of a bag should be tied so that wastes are not coming out of the bag when it is put into the garbage collection car.

-When the quantity of wastes is large (more than 15 kg at one time), please contact the Wastes Treatment Plants in advance and bring the wastes to the plants by yourself.

-Paper diapers can be collected when paper wastes are collected. Be sure to remove excrement from paper diapers beforehand.

-Incinerated ash should be brought to the Incombustible Wastes Treatment Plant by yourself.

\*Kitchen wastes should be **drained off** !

Type of Wastes	Rules to be kept when wastes are placed at the designated sites
<b>Metal Wastes</b>	-Bicycles (Front wheels should be removed beforehand.) -Umbrellas (Cloth should be removed and placed at the designated sites when plastic wastes are collected.) -Metal parts of gas ranges and oil heaters (The size should be smaller than 70 cm.) -Wastes of metal nets/bars should be cut into small pieces (Industrial wastes should not be included.) <b>*When you bring bicycles or tin plates to the treatment plant by yourself, it is not necessary to make them into small pieces.</b>
<b>Small-sized Electrical Appliances</b>	Small-sized electrical appliances (The size should be smaller than 50 cm.) Oven ranges, electric fans, fan heaters, vacuum cleaners, cassette players, video cassette recorders, watches, electric thermos, vacuum bottles, rice cookers, electric lamps, etc. (Please bring them to the treatment plant by yourself when the size of item is larger than 50 cm.) <b>*Any type of refrigerators (freezers), air conditioners, television sets and washing machines should be brought to electric shops or designated receiving stations by yourself.</b> <b>*Please contact the manufacturers for the treatment of personal computers.</b>
<b>Glass/Ceramic Wastes</b>	Window glass, mirror, incandescent lamps, ceramic cups/bowls, flowerpots <b>*Put the broken glass/ceramic wastes into transparent bags so that the wastes in the bag can be seen.</b> Rubble of concrete blocks or tiles (Industrial wastes should not be included.) <b>*Please bring them to the treatment plant by yourself when you have big lumps or big quantities (more than 15 kg) of them.</b> <b>*Mercury-type clinical thermometers should be placed at the designated recyclables collection stations as recyclables (fluorescent lamps) on the designated date.</b>
<b>Plastic Wastes</b>	Plastic products, rubber products (They should be cut into pieces smaller than 20 cm.) <b>*Plastic containers/packages such as containers or trays made of plastic should be placed at the designated recyclables collection stations as recyclables on the designated date.</b> Futons (Japanese mattresses), mattresses, carpets, rugs (They should be cut into pieces smaller than 50 cm and put into the bags designated by Komono Town, or they should be bound with plastic strings.) and stuffed dolls <b>*Clothing and cloths should be placed at the designated recyclables collection stations as recyclables on the designated date.</b>

Be sure to keep the rules!

\*Furniture (tables, chairs, sofas, wardrobes, drawers and forcers) should be disassembled into pieces smaller than 50 cm and separated into woods, plastic, metals, glass, and placed as wastes at the designated sites on the designated date of each waste. (Please bring them to the treatment plants by yourself when the quantity of them is large.)

\*Disposable-type pocket body warmers (After use, inner bags should be placed at the designated sites when plastic wastes are collected, and the contents should be placed at the designated sites when glass/ceramic wastes are collected.)

## Wastes that can NOT be accepted

(The following wastes can NOT be accepted even though you bring them to the treatment plants by yourself.)

Life-related wastes (household wastes) that can NOT be accepted	Way of treatment
Containers of agricultural chemicals/strong drugs, tires, LP gas cylinders, agricultural machines, batteries, motorcycles, four kinds of electrical appliances (refrigerators <freezers>, air conditioners, television sets and washing machines), personal computers, button-type batteries, rechargeable batteries (nickel-cadmium type or nickel type)	Please return them back to the shops you bought them or ask the authorized dealing companies to treat them.
