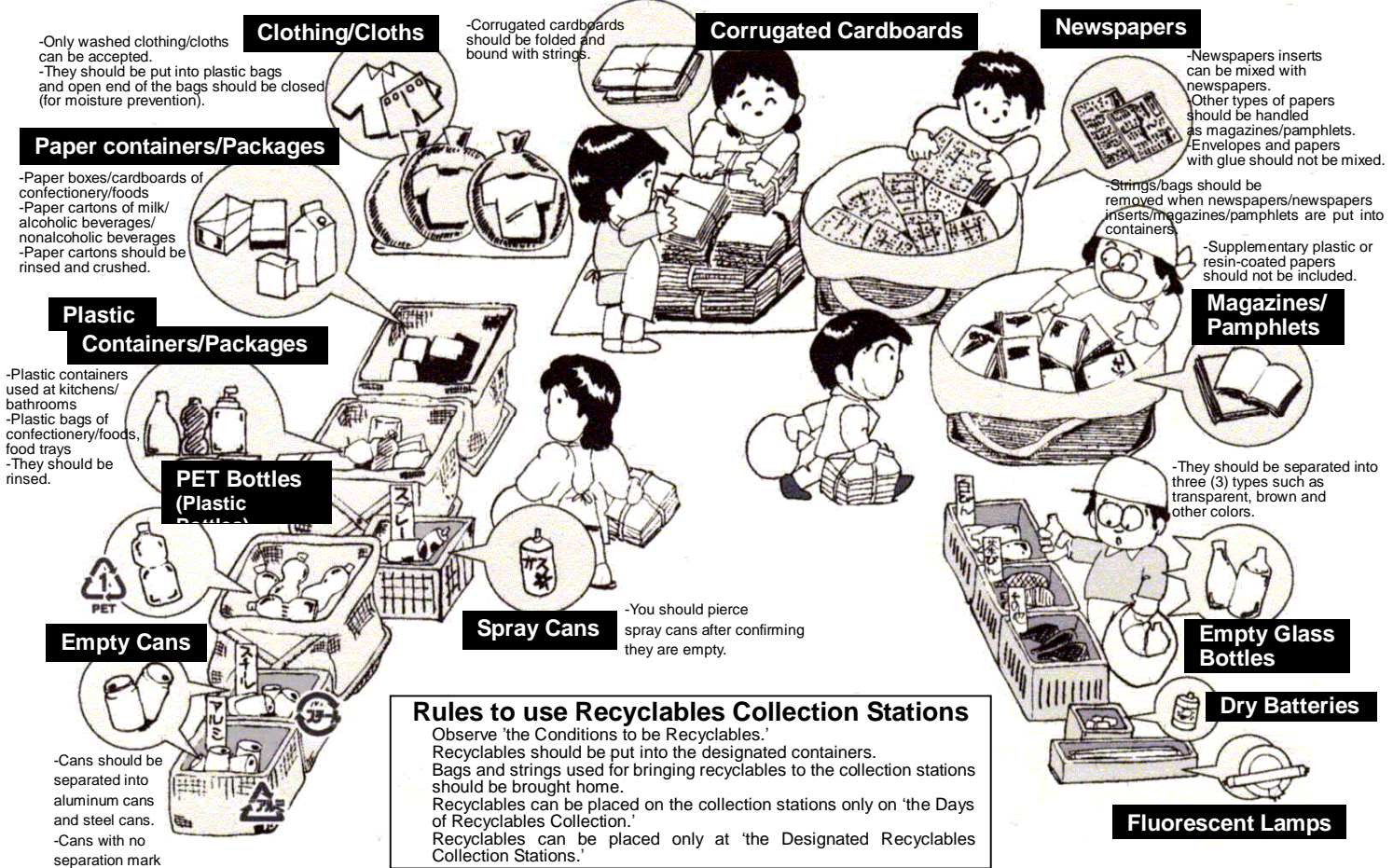


Illustrated Image of a Recyclables Collection Station

We are collecting used papers, cloths and containers/packages / Recyclable Items and Conditions to Be Recyclables

Recyclable Items	Major Recyclables	Conditions to be Recyclables
Corrugated Cardboards	Corrugated Cardboards	They should be folded and bound with strings.
Newspapers	Newspapers, Newspapers Inserts	NEVER mix envelopes or paper bags.
Magazines/Pamphlets	Comic Books, Books, Weekly Magazines, Catalogs, Notebooks, Copy Papers	Plastic or resin-coated papers should not be included.
Clothing/Cloths	*Only washed clothing/cloths can be accepted. *They should be reused as clothing, waste cloth or cushioning materials.	They should be put into plastic bags.
Paper Containers/Packages	-Paper Boxes/Cardboards of Confectionery, Foods and Daily Commodities -Paper Cartons of Milk, Alcoholic Beverages and Nonalcoholic Beverages	They should be rinsed and crushed. Big boxes should be folded.
Plastic Containers/Packages	-Plastic Containers/Bags of Detergents, Shampoos, Hair Conditioners, Fabric Softeners and Bleaching Agents -Plastic Bags of Confectionery and Foods -Plastic Trays of Foods -Polystyrene Cushioning Materials.	They should be rinsed. They should be crushed as much as possible. Caps should be removed. It is not necessary to remove the labels.
Spray Cans	Spray Cans for Stove Burners, Hair Spray Cans, Aerosol Spray Cans	Make them empty completely and pierce them at airy places (Make sure that they are empty.).
Empty Glass Bottles	Glass Bottles of Drinks, Foods and Daily Commodities	They should be rinsed. Tops and labels should be removed. They should be separated into three (3) colors.
Empty Cans/Metal Tops	-Cans of Drinks -Cans of Confectionery (smaller than 30 cm) -Cans of Foods	They should be rinsed. They should be separated into aluminum cans and steel cans.
PET Bottles (Plastic Bottles)	PET Bottles (Plastic Bottles) of Drinks and Foods	They should be rinsed. Tops and labels should be removed.
Dry Batteries	Alkali Batteries, Manganese Batteries	They should be placed at the designated sites as they are.
Fluorescent Lamps	Fluorescent Lamps of Linear Type, Circular Type or Bulb Type	They should not be broken.

*Items listed above are designated as recyclables and collected according to the regulations of "Komono Town Environmental Conservation Ordinance (common name)."
Recyclables should not be handled as wastes. However, recyclables can be placed at the designated sites of wastes when dirt of the recyclables can not be removed. The word of 'Dirty' should be written on 'the recyclables with dirt' when they placed at the designated sites of wastes.
